

Mr. Smith Went to Washington


Ken began his career at NASA and then the Office of Economic Opportunity in Washington, D.C. Later, he was a partner in a Virginia management consulting firm, Craver, Mathews, Smith, with a specialty in fundraising and direct marketing management. Their West Coast office evolved into a new firm, Dodd Smith Dann.

As a partner and creative director, his clients included Greenpeace, the Coral Reef Alliance, the Wildlife Conservation Society, the African Wildlife Foundation, the Simon Wiesenthal Center, the Sierra Club, Barbara Boxer for Senate, the Social Democratic Party in the U.K., and dozens of public television and radio stations, including KQED.

More About Ken Smith

Ken currently provides pro bono fundraising and funding management of \$5 million annually for two U.S. foundations working to stop elephant poaching in nine African nations, plus pro bono consulting to the Marine Mammal Center, the International Court Court for the Environment Coalition, and others.

He founded *Undercurrent*, the consumer guide for serious scuba divers in 1975; Ken still publishes and edits it under the nom de plume "Ben Davison".

Ken has earned a Basic Certification and has logged about 1,000 dives. His articles have appeared in *Outside Magazine, Men's Journal, Skin Diver*, and *Adventure Travel*. His novel, <u>Tropical Ice</u>, an environmental thriller based loosely on Captain Don, the founder of Bonaire diving, which he "discovered" on a sailing voyage that began in Sausalito. It was published by Water Street Press in March 2017.

He generously offers MSC Members a subscription to *Undercurrent as part of our membership.*

Other Interesting Stuff About Ken

Ken was a founding board member of Continental Savings and Loan Association in S.F., a board member of The Marine Mammal Center, the Milo Foundation, and the Mountain Play.

Finally, he holds a B.A. in Mathematics from the Univ of Washington, an M.A. in Government from George Washington University, and a D.P.A. (Doctorate in Public Administration) from the University of Southern California.

He has taught graduate courses at several universities.

By the way, his wife, Lucia Christopher, once a PADI instructor, certified Elliott Zalta in Maui.

September: Coastal Clean-Up: Possibly Kirby Cove. Date: TBD: Alyssa Ralston is coordinating.


