Adam is the Associate Director of Conservation Education at The Marine Mammal Center in the Marin Headlands — a global leader in marine mammal health, science and conservation, and the largest marine mammal hospital in the world.



Adam will tell how you can make a difference for our ocean.

TMMC rescues between 700-2,000 sick and injured seals, sea lions and other marine mammals each year from over 600 miles of the California coastline as well as the Big Island of Hawai'i.

A Whale of a Holograph.


And Arlene Rudy <u>send us this link</u> of a projection holographique inside a school gymnasium.


