

Wed., August 12th ZOOM Meeting: Amos Nachom, "In Harmony With Ocean Giants"

Because COVID-19 pandemic has negated global travel plans, our diving colleague Amos Nachom is available to present via ZOOM in August.

Amos, a master of photographing big animals worldwide, will discuss "In Harmony with Ocean Giants: Authentic Capture of wildlife Behavior".

He has free dived with blue whales off the Eastern Pacific, scuba dived with crocs in the Okavango delta, and gone face-to-face with the Great White Shark. He's one of only five people ever to swim and photograph a polar bear underwater, while more people (12) have walked on the moon.

Since 1980, he has explored every significant body of water from the North Pole to Antarctica. Amos's photographic vision is to raise awareness of ocean giants in their habitats. His images reflect respect and compassion for animals and wilderness.

His photographs strive to dispel the myth of "dangerous" wildlife and show harmonious interactions between man and animal.

As an explorer, he leads wildlife photography expeditions through www.BigAnimals.com. But photographing a polar bear in the open ocean had eluded him until he starred in a documentary in 2019 — "Picture of His Life" — winner of multiple film festivals. Many club members saw this amazing film pre-COVID at the Rafael Theatre.

Amos also received the <u>International SeaKeepers</u> <u>Society "Man of The Year" Award</u> for his conservation, education, and exploration contributions over the past 40 years. He was recently interviewed on CNN by <u>Christiane Amanpour</u> about the movie.

Amos lives in Pacific Grove CA. He photographs with RED cinema cameras and Nauticam housing, a Nikon still camera, Seacam housing and strobes.




Remember to always plan your dive based on the conditions, be aware of your skills and equipment, and, above all, always stay with your buddy.
