

Barely 5' tall and weighing about 100 lbs. dripping wet, she was usually wet during her remarkable and adventurous life.

#### A Long Beach native:

- She started ocean swimming as a child in the 1920s, then surfing, skin diving, and spearfishing.
- In the 1930s, she became a skin-diving instructor.
- In the 1940s, she was a "Rosie the Riveter" and a commercial fisher.
- In 1950, she became a charter member of the Long Beach Neptunes dive club.

#### More About Dottie Frazier, Trailblazer.

- In 1955, Dottie became the world's first certified female scuba instructor, began two years as a hard-hat diver, was the first female dive shop owner, and was even a wetsuit manufacturer for the U.S. Navy.
- In 2019, she was honored with the <u>Historical</u> <u>Diving Society</u> *Diving Pioneer Award*.
- In 2000, she was inducted in the Women Divers Hall of Fame.



Dottie's Dad make her first diving mask out of a fire hose, an inner tube, glass, tape, and glue.

After using that mask for the first time, Dottie said, "I could see everything under water as clear as if I were on the surface. From this time forward, this became my world. New discoveries presented themselves daily amid the constantly changing underwater wonderland."


#### MSC Masks for Sale: \$12/2, \$24/4.
