

May Meeting Recap: Alex Rose, "From Pole to Pole: Exploration With A Purpose"

Alex is an amazing diver, photographer, science editor, explorer, and environmentalist.

She presented a dazzling array of images and shared interesting anecdotes from her Elysium Epic Trilogy to the Antarctic, Coral Triangle, and Arctic. She hopes her trips inspire a greater understanding of these precious areas and draw attention to their impacts on climate change.





We learned that:

- Sea ice is the basis of the food chain
- There are >1,000 species of ice algae
- Reefs generate oxygen, food, jobs, blue carbon, recreation, medicine, biodiversity hotspots, and a nursery for juvenile fish


