But Iara Mandyn is a freediving and mermaid instructor at Bamboo Reef Scuba Diving Centers in San Francisco. Erena Shimoda, who presented earlier this year, attended a few of her workshops.

Specializing in underwater photography and performance work, she started at [Fathom Films](#) in 2009, which was the Bay Area's only dedicated underwater shooting studio. She's also been a choreographer, u/w talent coach, and model.


