Dan Orr, AKA "Captain America", provided an interesting, insightful, and educational presentation for divers 60 and older. He said, "Age should not be a barrier to diving your dreams" and he's living proof of what he preaches.

According to Divers Alert Network research in 2015, heart attacks are most common causes of deaths.
